

I want to thank you and your organization for the free nanny services that you have provided me and my family during this difficult time of fighting cancer. I was diagnosed in March of 2011 with Stage III Breast cancer. My treatment includes chemotherapy, radiation and hormone therapy. I have a 21 month old son that I have to take care of in the evenings Monday – Thursday and all day Saturday since my husband is at work and I am the sole care giver in the household during those times. My husband works nights and I was working days. I knew my income would be declining since I am commissioned base and not able to work my usual work load. As a result my income needed for paying bills declined and yet we needed nanny services to assist me with the child care in the evenings and on Saturday. We did and do not know have the extra income to pay for the nanny services. I found out about your organization that assisted cancer patients with free nanny services. The nanny services that your organization funds is exceptional. All of the nannies have provided excellent child care services and are all very experienced with children. There have been many days that I was too ill to watch, feed and change our toddler's diapers. Without these services I would have had a difficult time fighting the cancer. I am still in treatment until the end of September and receiving the free nanny services. I am so pleased with the nanny resources and grateful for the organization's financial assistance. I hope that A Small Miracle Foundation will continue receiving donations to assist those fighting cancer. Your organization has been a God Sent for me and my family.
